Notice of Co-Option

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that FREYSTROP COMMUNITY COUNCIL intends to Co-opt One Member to fill the vacancy that exists in the office of Councillor

Expressions of interest are being sought from members of the public who meet the following qualifications and are interested in representing their community on the aforementioned Community Council.

You must be a British citizen, a qualifying Commonwealth citizen, citizen of the Republic of Ireland, a relevant citizen of the Union or a qualifying foreign citizen and be 18 years old and meet at least one of the four qualifications below:

- registered as a local government elector for the community; or who has been
- during the whole of the twelve months preceding the appointment occupied as owner or tenant of the land or other premises in the community; or his/her
- principal or only place of work during those twelve months has been in the community; or has;
- during those twelve months resided in the community or within 3 miles of it;
- and is not disqualified from holding office by reason of any disqualification set out in section 80A of the Local Government Act 1972, or any decision made under section 79 of the Local Government Act 2000.
